- Section 10:** NAME OF INSURING PROVIDER OR OTHER SOURCE, TYPE OF SERVICE, and DATE OF SERVICE.
- Section 11:** BUSINESS OR NATURE OF ILLNESS OR INJURY.
- Section 12:** MEDICAL RESUBMISSION CODE, PHYSICIAN AUTHORIZATION NUMBER, and PHYSICIAN IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.
- Section 13:** PROCEDURE, SERVICES OR SUPPLIES, PLACE OF SERVICE, and DATE OF SERVICE.
- Section 14:** FEDERAL TAX ID NUMBER, SSN, PATIENT'S ACCOUNT NO., and ASSIGNMENT.
- Section 15:** SIGNATURE OF PHYSICIAN OR SUPPLIER, SERVICE FACILITY LOCATION INFORMATION, and BILLING PROVIDER INFO & PIN.

 Callouts from green boxes point to specific fields:
 

- FL 24G: Days or Units:** Points to field 11, 'ENTER QUANTITY OF DRUG PER HCPCS CODE UNIT HERE'. A note indicates 'Billing units=115, for 115 mg of fosaprepitant.' The value '115' is entered in this field.
- FL 24D: CPT/HCPCS:** Points to field 10, 'PROCEDURE, SERVICES OR SUPPLIES'. A note indicates 'Enter J1453.' The value 'J1453' is entered in this field.
- FL 24E:** Points to field 10, 'PROCEDURE, SERVICES OR SUPPLIES'. A note indicates 'The label for EMEND for Injection states that it should be administered as an infusion over 15 minutes. This corresponds to CPT code 96375: therapeutic, prophylactic, or diagnostic injection (specify substance or drug); each additional sequential intravenous push of a new substance/drug (list separately in addition to code for primary procedure).' The value '96375' is entered in this field.

This version includes fields for the mandated National Provider Identifiers. The previous CMS-1500 (12-90) form did not have these fields. EMEND® (aprepitant) and EMEND for Injection, in combination with other antiemetic agents, are indicated for prevention of acute and delayed nausea and vomiting associated with initial and repeat courses of highly emetogenic cancer chemotherapy, including high-dose cisplatin; and for prevention of nausea and vomiting associated with initial and repeat courses of moderately emetogenic cancer chemotherapy.

EMEND, when administered orally, is a moderate cytochrome P450 isoenzyme 3A4 (CYP3A4) inhibitor. Because fosaprepitant is rapidly converted to aprepitant, neither drug should be used concurrently with pimozone, terfenadine, astemizole, or cisapride. Inhibition of CYP3A4 by aprepitant could result in elevated plasma concentrations of these drugs, potentially causing serious or life-threatening reactions.
